- specialized year-round, brick and mortar independent K-12 school for children and adolescents with autism in British Columbia, accompanied by a licensed child care program.
- autism-specific adult program in BC offering employment training, job coaching, life skills, art, music & speech language therapy with an in-house behavioural analyst.

54 students + young adults

receive services from PALS Autism Society and PALS Adult Services Society

Why we have the *Imagine...Gala* \$76,000 - \$89,000

is the **true annual cost** for 1 student to attend PALS' specialized, year-round school program. Government grants cover only a small fraction, leaving parents to either pay the difference or decline their child's spot at PALS. **\$15,000 must be fundraised annually for each student** in order to keep tuition within reach for as many families as possible.

\$41,000 - \$78,000

is the **true annual cost** for 1 member to attend PASS' specialized, year-round adult program. Government funding does not cover any developmental therapies (speech, art and music, with behavioural therapy being the most costly), job support for adult members at volunteer worksites and managing the social enterprise. **\$6,000 must be fundraised annually for each adult member** in order to offer these exceptional programs at PASS.

The PALS Story

In July 2007, five mothers opened PALS Autism Society – School Program in a converted office space in East Vancouver. PALS quickly gained the support of like-minded individuals who recognized the need for a year-round, independent school in British Columbia for children with moderate to severe autism in kindergarten to grade 12.

The school utilizes the most up to date, evidence-based best practices and technologies throughout its educational, therapeutic and recreational programs. PALS School is a Group 1 Independent School, designated as one of 13 Special Education Schools by the BC Ministry of Education and Child Care.

PALS Autism Society also operates a licensed, affordable and flexible Before and After School Care Program. This provides students with additional opportunities for practicing social interactions with their peers through art, music, and recreation in a supported, fun environment, while also allowing families to work full-time hours thanks to the extended hours of care.

In 2010, PALS recognized the need for continued learning and established the Adult Program for transitioning young adults with autism ages 19 years and older, now known as PASS. Many PALS students have benefitted greatly from the opportunity to continue their learning at PASS after graduation.

In March 2019, the school experienced a milestone and relocated to its forever home in New Westminster. The Society was able to purchase a 10,000 square foot, three-story, heritage building through the generosity of donors and years of careful spending. Shortly after settling in, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic was felt deeply by the students, their families, and the staff. The aftermath is still present today due to the severe setbacks experienced in fundraising and expansion.

Over the past 16 years, the school has grown from 10 students up to 18 students; however, our goal is to fill the classrooms with as many students as possible in the large, New Westminster facility. With the constant support of our loyal donors, we are slowly and consistently returning to pre-pandemic operations. Two big steps in that direction will be welcoming an additional 5 students into the PALS community in the 2023/2024 school year, as well as introducing the brand-new role of Executive Director to the organization. Growth and sustainability are on the horizon, and the students of PALS will reap the benefits.

FULL POTENTIAL, MEANINGFUL LIVES

PALS Adult Services Society provides an innovative daily program and independent housing for adults with autism spectrum disorder.

PASS' approach is rooted in a continuum of skill development, community participation, employment, and independent housing opportunities.

As children with autism "age out" of the school system, they enter adulthood facing a significant lack of support and resources. PASS' autism-specific, development-based solutions ensure that members can live vibrant, meaningful lives. Led by a highly qualified team of autism spectrum disorder professionals, PASS' curriculum supports members in developing the life skills they need to become more independent and integrated in their community.

PASS' housing initiative currently provides 16 adults with autism and other developmental disabilities with the opportunity to live independently, with the appropriate level of support, in a community-based environment.

PASS began as PALS Adult Program but is now a separate and distinct charitable entity. As sister organizations, ties between the two remain strong with a shared vision to provide tailor-made support to people with autism.

PASS Marketplace

PASS Marketplace, our onsite social enterprise, is dedicated to assisting young adults with autism overcome workplace barriers. PASS members engage in vocational training by assisting with tasks that support the Marketplace while learning to work in a team setting and in social environments. Members are paid to produce and sell a variety of giftable products, including candles, cards, and spice blends. The enterprise also offers services such as custom label designs, product packaging, and product assembly.

The giveaway item for this year's gala, a lemon-citrus tea blend, was designed and assembled by members working in PASS Marketplace. Together, program members and facilitators researched Capri, Italy and were immediately inspired by the colours and nature of the island. Capri's abundance of citrus fruit and beautiful pink flowers brought them to the idea of lemon-flavored tea mixed with flower petals. Members assisted in every step of the process, from designing the artwork to mixing the tea blend to hand-labelling and assembling 400 tubes and tags.

In July 2007 PALS Autism School first opened its doors to 10 students all diagnosed with autism. For our first 5 years, generous donations from The Wolrige Foundation enabled PALS to purchase specialized, adaptive equipment and learning materials required to teach our special needs students.

Over the next 7 years, the School was privileged to receive funding which allowed us to contract the services of an essential occupational therapist. Thank you to The Wolrige Foundation for helping our students learn the simple skills of daily living.

For the past 4 years, The Wolrige Foundation has provided affordable before and after school care to all students who require this in order to attend the School program. Our Board of Directors, staff, students and their families are forever grateful to The Wolrige Foundation for significantly improving the lives of our students and their families living with autism.

Tonight, PALS would like to extend our congratulations to The Wolrige Foundation as they celebrate their 50th anniversary year. When Barbara and Alan Wolrige first established the Foundation in 1973, Barbara was a longtime Board Member of Sunny Hill Hospital and was dedicated to ensuring the well-being and care of children throughout British Columbia. Their legacy is carried on through their children, Jeff Wolrige and Anne Rowland. Since 2007, The Wolrige Foundation has donated an astounding \$200,000. We are deeply humbled and grateful for their continued philanthropy and commitment to the students and mission of PALS Autism Society.

YOUR IMPACT

Over the past 15 years, Gala sponsors, donors and guests have helped to raise a cumulative \$4.7 million which has been used to:

- Purchase in 2017 a new forever home for the School in New Westminster, BC
- Move and renovate the adult program in 2020 to a larger space in Vancouver to accommodate an increase in enrollment
- Keep school tuition and adult program fees affordable
- As designated essential services, kept the school and adult programs operating online or onsite throughout the pandemic
- Provide specialized programs to students and adult members using the most current adaptive and assistive technology and best practices for optimal learning outcomes
- Provide much needed but costly evidence-based therapies including art, music, behavioural, occupational and speech
- Assist students through a temporary behavioural crisis while enabling them to continue attending school
- Expand the Adult Program Social Enterprise (PASS Marketplace), which builds vocational skills and self-confidence, provides paid employment, and encourages independence
- Provide fun outings for students and adult members in a supported environment for safe integration into the community

Looking Forward...

PALS currently has 18 students and PASS currently has 36 adult members. Both programs have waitlists twice as long. With your help, we can increase our fundraising capacity to help more students, young adults, and their families access our life-changing programs this coming year. *Grazie!*



ABOUT AUTISM

Autism is a **lifelong** neurodevelopmental difference that **impacts all aspects of a person's life.** It is characterized by:

- differences in social communication and interaction
- restrictive and repetitive behaviours, actions, or interests

1 in 37 children have Autism in BC.


Autism affects all ethnic and socioeconomic groups.

69% of children and youth with autism **have another long-term health condition** compared to 22% of those without autism

There are **many misconceptions** about autism that are harmful and stigmatizing to autistic people. Contrary to common myths, autism is:

- Not curable
- Not a disease
- Not caused by diet
- Not caused by vaccines
- · Not caused by poor parenting
- Not only present in children
- Not only present in males

The **autism spectrum** is not a straight line from 'less autistic' to 'more autistic.' Instead, the term 'spectrum' refers to how an autistic person **functions in each of these domains:**



Each year an estimated **5,000 teens** with autism will become adults in BC and **lose school-based autism services.** As adults, many must start building support systems again from scratch, often with less resources, less help and aging parents.

How do I register?

Registering to bid is super easy! Head to https://pals.cbo.io or scan the **above QR code.** If you haven't registered before click the 'Register Now' button and complete the form. You will be asked to enter your details so we can contact you if you win an auction item. Your credit card will only be charged in the case that you are a successful bidder or make a donation. You can sign in using your email address or phone number.

How do I make a bid?

- Visit https://pals.cbo.io or scan the QR code above.
- Log in by entering in your cell phone number or your email address and tap GO. If you enter your cell phone number, you will receive a text with a one-time login code. If you enter your email address, you will receive an email with a one-time login code.
- Browse auction items by category or simply scroll through all items.
- To place a bid, tap on the blue "Bid/Info" button. There you can place a fast bid, bid, or set a max bid, and read details about items.
- You will see a congratulations screen letting you know that your bid has been placed successfully.
- If you're outbid, you will receive a text message or email letting you know. At this point, you can either bid again or set a 'max bid' amount and let Click Bid do the bidding for you, up to that amount.
- When the auction closes, you will receive a message letting you know if you are the winning bidder.
- Your registered credit card (on the ClickBid auction site) will be charged automatically, unless you have advised otherwise prior to this time, at 9:30pm on April 28, 2023 for any items won or purchased. For in-person guests, you may choose to pay with an alternative method at the Auction Checkout Area, before 8:00pm.

Collection Of Your Items

For in-person guests, successful bidders will be able to pick up their item(s) at the Auction Checkout Area, located at Registration, after 10:00pm. Volunteers will be available for those who require assistance to their car.


