## ABOUT PALS + PASS



specialized year-round, brick and mortar independent K-12 school for children and adolescents with autism in British Columbia, accompanied by a licensed child care program

autism-specific adult program in B.C. offering employment training, job coaching, life skills, art, music & speech language therapy with an in-house behavioural analyst

### 22 STUDENTS + 43 YOUNG ADULTS

receive services from PALS Autism Society and PALS Adult Services Society



**\$77,000 - \$91,000** is the **true annual** cost for 1 student to attend PALS' specialized, year-round school program. Government grants cover only a small fraction, leaving parents to either pay the difference or decline their child's spot at PALS. **\$15,000 must be fundraised annually** for each student in order to keep tuition within reach for as many families as possible.

**\$42,000 - \$79,000** is the **true annual** cost for 1 member to attend PASS' specialized, year-round adult program. Government funding does not cover any developmental therapies (speech, art and music), job support for adult members at volunteer worksites or managing the social enterprise. **\$7,000 must be fundraised annually for each adult member** in order to offer these exceptional programs at PASS.

### INDIVIDUALIZED, INTERACTIVE, INSPIRED. The PALS Story

In July 2007, five mothers opened PALS Autism Society – School Program in a converted office space in East Vancouver. PALS quickly gained the support of like-minded individuals who recognized the need for a year-round, independent school in British Columbia for children with moderate to severe autism in kindergarten to grade 12.

The school utilizes the most up to date, evidence-based best practices and technologies throughout its educational, therapeutic and recreational programs. PALS School is a Group 1 Independent School, designated as one of 13 Special Education Schools by the BC Ministry of Education and Child Care.

PALS Autism Society also operates a licensed, affordable and flexible Before and After School Care Program. This provides students with additional opportunities for practicing social interactions with their peers through art, music, and recreation in a supported, fun environment, while also allowing families to work full-time hours thanks to the extended hours of care.

In 2010, PALS recognized the need for continued learning and established the Adult Program for transitioning young adults with autism and other neuro-developmental disabilities. Pals Adult Services Society, now known as PASS, supports adult participants and their families by providing comprehensive programs, services, and housing options. Many PALS students benefit from the opportunity to continue their learning at PASS.

In March 2019, the school experienced a milestone and relocated to its forever home in New Westminster. The Society was able to purchase a 10,000 square foot, three-story, heritage building through the generosity of donors and years of careful spending.

In recent years, the school has grappled with the profound repercussions of the COVID-19 pandemic with significant setbacks in programming and expansion initiatives. The 2023/2024 school year marked the closing of the pandemic chapter for PALS, with the reintroduction of programming vital to student independence, well-being, and safety. Activities previously deemed unsafe during the pandemic, such as work placements, meal and snack preparation, swimming lessons, and hands-on life skills, are now back in full swing!

Continuing this positive trajectory, this year the school expanded to its largest enrollment numbers to date, increasing enrollment by 22% and adding a third classroom. In the fall of 2023, PALS hired a new Head of School and the former HOS has taken on a newly created part time Executive Director position. PALS is hopeful that, with the support of our loyal donors, further expansion and financial sustainability are on its horizon and the students of PALS will reap the benefits.

## FULL POTENTIAL, MEANINGFUL LIVES.

PASS provides an innovative daily program and independent housing for adults with autism spectrum disorder and other developmental disabilities. Our approach is rooted in a continuum of skills development, community participation, employment, and independent housing opportunities.

As children with autism "age out" of the school system, they enter adulthood facing a significant lack of support and resources. PASS' autism-specific, development-based solutions ensure members can live vibrant, meaningful lives. Led by a highly qualified team of autism spectrum disorder professionals, PASS' curriculum supports members in developing the life skills they need to become more independent and integrated in their community.

In 2023, PASS opened a second location in Burnaby, positioning us to include up to 25 new members in our daily program.

PASS' housing initiative currently provides 16 adults with autism and other developmental disabilities with the opportunity to live independently of their families, with the appropriate level of support, in a community-based environment.

PASS is now a separate charitable entity from PALS Autism Society, but ties between the two remain strong with a shared vision to provide tailor-made support to people with autism and other developmental disabilities.

#### **PASS Marketplace**

PASS Marketplace, our onsite social enterprise, is dedicated to helping young adults overcome workplace barriers. PASS members engage in vocational training by assisting with tasks that support the Marketplace while learning to work in a team setting. Members are paid to produce various giftable products, including candles, cards, and spice blends, and offer services such as custom label designs, product packaging, and product assembly. Marketplace recently received the Workplace Inclusion Champion Award for Social Enterprise at the 2023 Untapped Awards.

Creative expression is paramount to PASS Marketplace, and Art Cards are one of our popular products. PASS members created brand-new exclusive designs for this year's Gala giveaway item. These Art Cards feature original paintings by Chris O., Fraser, J.A., Oshen, and Tanya, building on the theme "what PASS means to us." Additionally, members produced elaborate string art that will be available to bid on in tonight's auction.

### **TONIGHT'S HONOREE**

Burnaby Firefighters Charitable Society in Partnership with the Marilyn and Alan Codyre Memorial Fund



For the past 17 years, the Burnaby Firefighters Charitable Society has played a critical role in supporting PALS Autism School. Their generosity and compassion have been a part of the foundation of many of the school's programs and activities, helping students with autism achieve their goals and reach their full potential.

When PALS opened its doors in 2007, the Burnaby Firefighters Charitable Society provided funds that enabled the school to purchase our first pieces of specialized furniture for students with autism, signaling we moved from a dream to a reality. This significant contribution allowed the school to create a supportive and nurturing learning environment for its students.

Since then, the Burnaby Firefighters
Charitable Society has provided over
\$85,000 in cumulative grants which have
been used for online educational programs,
life skills cooking and community awareness
programs, field trip transportation for
summer programs, and behavioural support
funding. Pals also benefited from the
very popular firefighter dinners that were
auctioned at previous Imagine... Galas.
In 2017, the Burnaby Firefighters Charitable
Society, in partnership with the Marilyn and
Alan Codyre Memorial Fund, committed

to providing PALS with \$100,000 over 10 years. This was a significant milestone for the school, as it meant that PALS could continue to provide critical support to its students for years to come. In 2019, we received an incredible surprise when the pledge was doubled to \$200,000 and extended for an additional 10 years. Each year, the fund disburses \$10,000 that can be used to support students in various ways, such as providing bursaries, school supply subsidies, and post-secondary scholarships to graduating students.

PALS is extremely thankful for the sustained backing and kindness of the Burnaby Firefighters Charitable Society, which has been a lifeline for many of its students and their families. The charity's unwavering commitment enables PALS to maintain an inclusive and supportive learning environment, where students with autism can flourish and reach their maximum potential.



## YOUR IMPACT

## Over the past 17 years, Gala sponsors, donors and guests have helped to raise a cumulative \$5.2 million which has been used to:

- Purchase in 2017 a new forever home for the School in New Westminster, BC
- Move the adult program in 2020 to a larger space in Vancouver and expanded in 2023 to create a new Burnaby campus to accommodate an increase in enrollment
- Help subsidize school and adult program to keep fees affordable
- Provide specialized programs to students and adult members using the most current adaptive and assistive technology and best practices for optimal learning outcomes
- Provide much needed but costly evidence-based therapies including art, music, behavioural, occupational and speech
- Assist students through a temporary behavioural crisis while enabling them to continue attending school
- Expand the Adult Program Social Enterprise (PASS Marketplace), which builds vocational skills and selfconfidence, provides paid employment, and encourages independence
- Provide paid and volunteer employment experiences with individualized assistance when needed
- Provide fun outings and recreational activities for students and adult members in a supported environment for safe integration into the community

#### **Looking Forward...**

PALS currently has 22 students and PASS currently has 43 adult members. With your help, we can increase our fundraising capacity to help more students, young adults, and their families access our life-changing programs this coming year.

### **ABOUT AUTISM**



Autism is a **lifelong** neurodevelopmental difference that **impacts all aspects of a person's life.** It is characterized by:

- Differences in social communication and interaction
- Restrictive and repetitive behaviours, actions, or interests

1 in 32 children have Autism in BC.

Autism affects all ethnic and socioeconomic groups.

**69%** of children and youth with autism **have** another long-term health condition compared to 22% of those without autism

There are **many misconceptions** about autism that are harmful and stigmatizing to autistic people. Contrary to common myths, autism is:

- Not curable
- Not a disease
- Not caused by diet
- Not caused by vaccines
- Not caused by poor parenting
- Not only present in children
- Not only present in males

The **autism spectrum** is not a straight line from 'less autistic' to 'more autistic.' Instead, the term 'spectrum' refers to how an autistic person **functions in each of these domains:** 



Each year an estimated **5,000 teens** with autism will become adults in BC and **lose school-based autism services**. As adults, many must start building support systems again from scratch, often with less resources, less help and aging parents.
